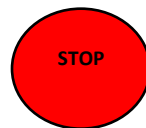
Q1. Should we follow traffic rules?

Ans. The 'red light' indicates STOP.



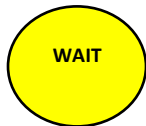
Q3. What does the 'green light' indicate?

Lesson no. 16: WHAT ARE THEY MADE OF

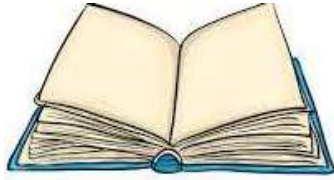
Q1. What is a pencil made of?

Ans. A pencil is made of wood and lead.



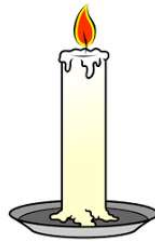
Q2. What are books made of?

Q5. What is a shirt made of?

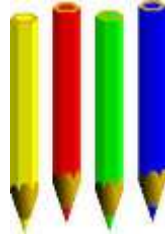
Ans. A shirt is made of cloth.
